



The Delta Dental Health Theatre has had a very exciting year as we plan and work towards moving into our new location. This year was spent working towards diversifying our funding streams by adding corporate sponsorships, focusing on grants, and adding a \$1 admission fee per visitor which went into effect at the end of July. We are looking forward to another great year in 2009 starting out with January—March bookings which already exceed our numbers for this past year.

A Partnership with Delta Dental of Missouri

In 2004, Delta Dental of Missouri (DDMO) became a primary, permanent sponsor of the Dental Health Theatre, changing the name to the Delta Dental Health Theatre (DDHT). The generous donations will be used to enhance the Delta Dental Health Theatre's experience through the addition of our new "Be Tobacco Free" program and to upgrade the Theatre's technology through the addition of a remote control education system, known as eInstruction Classroom Performance System. As we move forward and add new programs, exhibits, and ex-

There are many new opportunities to support our efforts. Our Program

The Delta Dental Health Theatre is committed to providing our community's children a fun and memorable educational experience. Our unique design, blending education and entertainment, promises to inspire children and adults to take care of their teeth and gums, and to make healthy choices including proper nutrition and physical fitness. Although we know that we cannot provide three well-balanced meals daily to the 10,000 children we see each year, we do know that we can provide them with both the dental education and the dental tools needed to help fight tooth decay. St. Louis public schools, Head Start centers, daycare centers and other nonprofit organizations take routine field trips to our theatre seeking out a fun, interactive, educational destination. Our admission costs \$1 which includes a Healthy Smile Kit for every participant.

We want to make sure that every child is equipped with the proper tools to fight tooth decay following our 45 minute program.

The Theatre is open Tuesday-Saturday from 9am-3pm. We offer show times at 9:30am, 11am, and 1:30pm. We welcome all visitors to attend our shows but do encourage groups of ten or more to call in advance and reserve a show time. Please call today to schedule a show time for your group or family.314-241-7391. Admission to see a show is only \$1. Delta Dental Health Theatre does offer scholarship opportunities please visit our website at www.ddhtstl.org to download a scholarship form.

Children and families can expect to learn the importance of taking good care of our smiles and health. As a result of seeing our show kids will better understand how to properly brush and floss their teeth, that the dentist is our friend and we should visit the dentist twice per year, and finally how to choose a healthy lifestyle through nutrition, exercise, and even self esteem.

This show will be an option for families and school groups to request as either an add on to our current show or as a full length 45 minute anti tobacco program.
